About Us

The Fairfield County Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit, and its many supporters help to enhance the quality of life and economic viability of our community. The Foundation was formed in 1989, when Probate Judge S. Farrell Jackson challenged our community to establish a foundation to keep significant trust funds invested locally. A small committee of caring citizens joined together to establish the Foundation to provide an entity to administer contributions from individuals, families, corporations and organizations.

Our Mission

Our mission is to receive and administer charitable gifts that will provide long-term, continuing benefits to Fairfield County and its residents by supporting educational, scientific, cultural, social, environmental, medical and other charitable purposes.

The Foundation is accredited by the National Standards for U.S. Community Foundations Program, demonstrating that it has met the nation's highest philanthropic standards for operational quality, integrity and accountability.





Dear Valued Friend of the Foundation,

This was a year of celebration for the Fairfield County Foundation. A celebration of the individuals, families, corporations and organizations that have supported us over the past 25 years, helping us to build a legacy that will enable future generations to meet the needs of our changing community.

It is truly remarkable to think about all that we have accomplished together since 1989, when Probate Judge S. Farrell Jackson challenged local citizens to establish a community foundation. Despite many obstacles, Judge Jackson, Bob Johnston and Bill Sitterley persevered and successfully got the Foundation off the ground with just one staff member, one fund and \$230,000 in assets. In 25 years, the Foundation has grown to a staff of five, more than 250 funds and assets of nearly \$40 million at the end of 2014.

The Foundation's original fund supported elderly women and senior citizens in the community. Today, the Foundation supports the arts, children's programs, health and wellness projects, community development, academics and much more. From scholarships for deserving Fairfield County youth and grants to improve our historic buildings, to improvements to green spaces throughout our county and grants to feed the hungry, the Fairfield County Foundation has touched every member of our community in some way over the years.

None of this would be possible without the wisdom and courage of our founders, and the generous support of so many community members throughout our first 25 years. On behalf of the board, staff and all of those who have reaped the benefits of your generosity, we humbly say "thank you" and look forward to many more years of serving this wonderful community we are fortunate to call home!

A LOOK BACK AT 2014

Thanks to our remarkable donors, we had much to celebrate throughout our silver anniversary year. In addition to honoring our history and recognizing the many accomplishments of the Foundation over the years, in 2014 we continued to focus on growing our assets and providing support to the people and organizations who make our community such a great place to call home.

- \$39,548,796 in total assets as of December 31, 2014
- 189 grants to public charities in Fairfield County, totaling more than \$1,645,522
- \$655,500 through 391 scholarships awarded to Fairfield County students to help in their goal to attain higher education
- \$3,134,605 in contributions from more than 1,400 individuals and families who made 1,475 gifts in memory of loved ones to support a special fund or charity, to establish a new fund, or as end of life gifts.
- 13 new funds were established:

Fairfield County Foundation grants impact all aspects of our community:

- Grants to agencies that provide critical services including Salvation Army Samaritan Adult Service Center, American Red Cross of Fairfield County Community Disaster Program, Foundation Dinners, Charity Newsies, Meals on Wheels, Fairfield Center for disAbilities & Cerebral Palsy, Fairfield Housing and Fairfield County Food Pantries.
- Support for arts and culture through organizations such as Decorative Arts Center of Ohio, Lancaster Chorale, The Lancaster Festival, Ohio Glass Museum, Ohio University Lancaster Wagner Theatre and Cameo League.
- Grants that have enhanced the quality of life and activities in our community including Lancaster Police-Safety Town, Boy Scouts Fairfield County Day Camp, United Way Imagination Library, Destination Downtown Holiday Decorations, Family Y Rec Plex, Pickerington-Violet TWP Historical Society and West After School Center.
- Support for organizations that serve the health of our citizens such as AEDs for area businesses and schools, matching funds for Area TWIGs, Community HealthFest, Family Y Livestrong Program, Mid-Ohio Psychological Services, Southeast Ohio Sight Center and Tyler's Light Drug Free Clubs.



Setting up a Fund with the Foundation

Your Foundation is here to help you build your legacy. We can help you determine your charitable goals, such as deciding if you want family members involved, both now and/or in the future; consider how much involvement you want in selecting the charitable organizations that will receive grants from your fund; and think about how much you want to give in charitable contributions each year and how you want to give it.

We make giving easy and effective, accepting a wide variety of gifts and providing donors with a number of charitable options. Our professional staff has in-depth understanding of the issues, opportunities and resources that shape our community. The Foundation has several options for setting up a fund that best meets your giving goals, including the following:

- **Donor-Advised Funds:** This type of fund enables donors or their designees to recommend grants based on their personal charitable interests.
- **Unrestricted Funds:** Unrestricted Funds are gifts to the Foundation's unrestricted general fund. The principal and income is distributed at the Foundation's discretion in the form of grants to 501(c) (3) organizations. A minimum gift of \$5,000 is required to establish a named fund. Gifts of any amount are accepted into the general fund.
- **Scholarship Funds:** Individuals, families, companies or organizations can establish Scholarship Funds. Once in place, a Scholarship Fund continues to grow with additional contributions from the original donors, from other contributions and through market growth. The donor of a Scholarship Fund has the ability to define the scholarship's advisory committee and the guidelines for candidate selection, requirements and award use.
- **Agency Funds or Endowments:** Agency Funds or Endowments can be created to perpetually support your community service agency. Agency funds hold assets for a charitable organization and distribute the principal or earned income in accordance with the agency's specific instructions.
- **Designated Funds:** Designated Funds are established to ensure that support will be provided to specific eligible non-profit organizations, often organizations that donors have been involved with during their lifetimes. This is an opportunity to leave a lasting legacy in the donor's name.



Making a Gift to the Foundation

A variety of assets can be used to make charitable gifts and there are many ways that you can give immediately or in the future.

- **Cash:** Cash gifts are an easy way to make an impact in your community and allow you to give at any time.
- **Securities:** Securities, both publicly traded and closely held, can be used to set up a fund.
- **Real and Personal Property:** Gifting real and personal property often allows an individual to contribute more than they may have thought possible.
- **IRA/Retirement/Pension Fund Assets:** Retirement assets are most often used as testamentary gifts, creating charitable funds as part of an overall estate plan.
- **Life Insurance:** Life insurance makes it possible to make meaningful gifts to the community.
- **Unique Assets:** Examples might include stamp, coin or art collections; copyrights and patents; royalties; or other unique assets of value.
- **Wills and Bequeaths:** Bequests offer varied ways of giving to the Foundation. Cash securities or other property may be bequeathed in one's will.

- **Charitable Remainder Trusts:** A Charitable Remainder Trust provides life-long income for one or several income beneficiaries, such as the donor and the donor's spouse, and leaves the remainder interest to the Foundation or designated beneficiary.

- **Charitable Lead Trusts:** The income generated from assets placed in a Charitable Lead Trust is paid to the Foundation for a period of years, after which the trust is terminated and the assets are returned to the donor.

- **Charitable Gift Annuities:** The Charitable Gift Annuity can make it possible for donors to assist the community in the future while providing lifetime income for themselves. Upon the death of the donor, the remaining principal is retained by the Foundation to carry out the donor's charitable intentions.

- **Transfer of a Private Foundation:** This type of gift affords many advantages, including lower overhead, staff to assist with charitable goals, and a higher tax deduction for any future gifts, to name a few.

RESTORING A HISTORIC LANDMARK TO HELP CHANGE LIVES

In 2012, The Rutherford House, located on Lancaster-Fairfield Community Action Agency's 25-acre campus, began the process of a \$2.9 million renovation that transformed the former orphanage into 16 apartments to be used as permanent supportive housing for families with disabilities. The project, named in honor of Edward and Maxine Rutherford, the long-serving superintendent and matron of the Fairfield County Children's Home, was designed to address a priority need identified in Fairfield County's Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness and Continuum of Care Plan. It is a unique housing solution for the community's most vulnerable families as it provides a broad range of on-site supportive services that are designed to move families toward self-sufficiency.

The restoration of the building, which is on the National Register of Historic Places, provided new mechanical systems, fire-safety systems, and accessibility features to meet modern living standards and building codes. In addition, many intact historic features were preserved, such as ornamental tin ceilings, wood wainscoting, stained glass in the upper sash of the second and third story windows, and stained glass arched windows on the fourth story. The Fairfield County Foundation, one of many local organizations that helped fund the project, provided a grant of \$50,000 from the George and Dollie Zimpfer Fund.

"In 1886, the Fairfield County Commissioners committed this property

to serve the children of our community's most vulnerable families by establishing the Children's Home. 130 years later, the Fairfield County Foundation has provided funding that helped us recommit the oldest buildings on this property to the same purpose." said Kellie Ailes, Executive Director of Lancaster-Fairfield County Community Action Agency. "The generosity of the Fairfield County Foundation is greatly appreciated by our staff, board of directors and the 16 special needs families and individuals who began to call Rutherford House home this year."



FUNDS

Donor Advised Funds

This type of fund is one of our most appealing charitable vehicles. Donor Advised Funds make possible several options, such as: making a charitable gift now; the ability to make suggestions regarding which charities you would like to support; setting up a fund through your will/estate; naming certain people as advisors to your fund. Donors receive both tax and philanthropic benefits in a simple format with a high degree of flexibility.

Christian Stewardship – to provide financial assistance for charitable causes, not exclusively, but with emphasis on, supporting Christian-based efforts such as evangelism, missionary support, and providing for the needy both within and outside Fairfield County.

Donley Family – distributions shall be made primarily to charitable organizations that provide services primarily in the area of Pickerington or Violet Township.

Charles and Diana Eversole Family – to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County, Ohio, for public, charitable and educational purposes, with special consideration given to the Fairfield Heritage Association and matching funds to the Fairfield Medical Center Foundation.

Hubie and Jenny Eyman Memorial – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the residents of Fairfield County.

Lorelei and David Gibbs Family – to support charitable organizations.

Great Commission – to support charitable organizations and to further the teachings of Jesus Christ, whether local, national, or worldwide.

The Rotary Club of Lancaster-Sherman Fred & Margie Hatcher Endowment – to support the needs of the Lancaster and Fairfield County community.

Harcum Family Fund – to provide financial assistance for charitable organizations.

Heiber Family – to be used for public, charitable and education purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the residents of Fairfield County.

Jackson Family – to provide charitable programs which will aid the children and aged of Fairfield County and Bloom Township.

David L. Johns – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes for Fairfield County.

Jennie L. Johns – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide ultimate benefit for the people of Amanda, Ohio.

Robert C. Kalish Memorial Youth Park Program – to provide funds for summer youth camp program for fourth and fifth graders attending Liberty Union-Thurston School District or who reside in the school district, at no charge to the child.

Jayne and Jim McGill Family – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the children in Fairfield County, Ohio.

Terry A. McGhee/Sally J. Grimm Community – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes.

Mowry Family – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County.

Norman Family – for public, charitable and educational programs that will benefit projects in and for the people of Fairfield County.

Joe Ogilvie – to benefit Duke University, The Inner City Educational Foundation, and grants for educational endeavors in Fairfield County and elsewhere.

Pickering Family – to provide funds for charitable purposes in Fairfield County.

Rodenbaugh Family – to provide funds for charitable purposes.

Brian Stoner Memorial – to provide funds to charitable organizations that are eligible to receive distributions. Preference for grants may be given to organizations dealing with individuals with special needs. Preference for scholarships may be given to students attending culinary school and/or students who have been diagnosed as being on the autism spectrum.

Rich & Delores Troup Family – to provide funds for charitable purposes in Fairfield County.

Williamson Family – a family directed fund that will provide funds for charitable purposes.

Scholarship Funds

Scholarship funds help students pursue their academic goals. The donor may define the guidelines for the recipient, the advisory committee, the school and the award itself.

Matthew Acton – to provide scholarships for senior golf athletes of any Fairfield County High School, Canal Winchester High School, Circleville High School, Logan Elm High School or Teays Valley High School. This scholarship is for any accredited college or vocational school.

Roger Anderson – for students residing in Jackson Township of Perry County and majoring in education or business.



FUNDS

The Anderson/Black/Community (ABC) Mini-Scholarship – The ABC Mini-Scholarship will be given to two individuals annually in amounts of \$750.00 each. Eligible applicants shall include current students in grades 9 through 12, staff members, administrators and retired staff members who had five years of service to the Bloom-Carroll Local School District. The two classifications of the scholarship shall be to fund a Christian Mission Trip (CMT) or a Christian Mission Project (CMP).

The Aranda Notre Dame Law School – to provide scholarships to students who have been accepted to the Notre Dame Law School.

Paul D. Beck – recipients must be a graduate of a high school located in Fairfield County, Ohio. Recipients must demonstrate academic ability and maintain a 3.5 GPA in high school and a 3.0 G.P.A. in any undergraduate program.

Bloom-Carroll Alumni Scholar Athlete – for Bloom-Carroll graduates who participate in sports and also demonstrate academic excellence.

William W. Bolsen Memorial – to provide scholarships for graduates of the Ohio State School for the Blind who wish to work toward a degree from a technical, two-year or four-year college.

Marlowe Brainard – to provide a scholarship for students attending and graduating from Millersport High School who desire to continue their education in the field of Arts or Education.

Jean M. Burdette Memorial – for Lancaster High School graduates for study in the field of Special Education.

James Caple – to provide scholarships for post-secondary studies for Fairfield County residents who pursue a course of study in classical vocal or instrumental performance.

Robert E. & Marion A. Carr – for Fairfield County residents who are pursuing a degree in the study of Nursing and/or Teaching/Education.

Molly Ann Clark Memorial – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for students who meet the following criteria: between the ages of 17-21; from Fairfield, Perry, Pickaway, Hocking, Licking, Athens or Muskingum county; demonstrate an interest in community service and volunteerism; and a past participant (racer) of the Lancaster Soap Box Derby, past Derby queen or have had a family member who either volunteered or served on the board of directors of the Lancaster Soap Box Derby. Applicants meeting the above criteria will be given preference in determining recipients, or a student seeking a degree in substance abuse education may be accepted every even year.

Charles C. & Barbara Claypool – for students seeking educational opportunities in technical fields with a preference toward engineering. Preference given to the children of employees of Claypool Electric Inc. and students planning to attend Ohio Northern University.

Deputy Ethan Collins – to provide scholarships for Fairfield County students to attend an accredited school or academy in preparation for a career in Law Enforcement or continuing education in Law Enforcement.

Coney Memorial – for Fairfield Union High School graduates.

Susie McMackin Crook – will be awarded to a student who has registered and been accepted at Lancaster Montessori School.

D.A.R.E. – scholarship recipient shall be a graduating senior from Lancaster High School, William V. Fisher Catholic High School or Fairfield Christian Academy and a graduate of the D.A.R.E. Program who desires to continue their education.

Davidson-J.C. Community Service – to provide scholarships to students of Fairfield County.

Jillian Davidson Memorial – this fund was established by family and friends to honor the memory of Jillian Leigh Davidson who died of a rare blood disease in September 2000. This scholarship is awarded to a female senior basketball or volleyball athlete at Lancaster High School. This award is given to the individual selected by the Davidson Scholarship Committee.

Elsie R. McClelland Davis Memorial – for graduates of Amanda-Clearcreek High School.

Jim DePietro – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for college students in the manner described: 1. Applicant must be a high school senior and a Lancaster Y Swim Team (LYST) swimmer. 2. LYST swimmer must have been a participant of the LYST program for at least two years prior to application. 3. Seniors wishing to apply will be asked to write an essay, using an essay prompt determined by the (active) LYST Parent Board Committee.

Frank Dillard Memorial/Standing Stone National Bank – for graduates of Fairfield County High Schools. Preference given to biological or legally adopted dependents of Standing Stone National Bank employees. Weighted toward those who plan to major in Business/Finance at Ohio University Lancaster.

Charles E. Dupler – to provide financial assistance to Fairfield Union High School music and F.F.A. students.

Chad Edwards Memorial – to provide scholarships for Fairfield County students to attend an accredited school or academy in preparation for a career in law enforcement or to further their career in law enforcement.

Leroy and Bernice Ellinger Memorial – for any graduate of a Fairfield County high school or any graduate from a high school in Worthington, Ohio. Preference will be given to a graduate of Lancaster High School. Applicant must be a college junior or senior and preference given to an accredited four year college. Recipient must have at least a 2.75 GPA going into their junior year. There will be one award of \$4,000.

Fairfield County Educational Service Center Superintendent's Scholarship – for students within Fairfield County based on academic achievement and school activities.

Fairfield Federal Ron Keaton – to provide scholarships for Lancaster High School senior varsity girls basketball players.

Amelia Fickel-Glenn Moodie – to provide scholarships for graduates of Perry-Southern Local School District. Special consideration given to graduates who are residents of the former New Straitsville School District. Selection shall be based on financial need. May be awarded for a four-year, two-year vocational or technical college education.

Lorelei Owen Gibbs – for residents of Fairfield County pursuing a university degree in Elementary Education or Nursing.

O.J. Green Memorial – to be used to provide scholarships to the most inspirational senior football player and to one senior art student at Canal Winchester High School.

Robert V. Grilli Memorial – to provide a scholarship for graduates of Lancaster High School and Fisher Catholic High School who desire to continue their education in a collegiate and/or graduate institution.

Jacob Guisinger Memorial – to provide a scholarship for a graduate of Berne Union High School, a pay-to-participate scholarship for a Berne Union High School Football player, a scholarship for the Fairfield County Youth Baseball or a scholarship for the Fairfield County Youth Football participant.

Nils Gustavson Scholar Athlete – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for a senior graduate of Lancaster High School meeting the following criteria: Recipient must be attending an Ohio school; recipient must be a student who, in the committee's opinion, has a good academic standing and has displayed the qualities of a scholar athlete; recipient should be involved in school athletics.



J. Jay Hampson – for students residing in Fairfield County and attending Ohio Northern University.

Doug Henwood Memorial – to provide scholarships to Lancaster High School graduates who participate in track and may be involved in track at the collegiate level.

William D. Hilyard Family – to be used to reward the outstanding senior music student of Fairfield Union High School. The award shall be known as the “Robert Trocchia Outstanding Music Student Award” given by the Family of William D. Hilyard.

Hocking Valley Dental Society Fund – to provide scholarships for students in Dental Hygiene or Expanded Function Dental Assisting. Students must be a graduate of a high school within the counties served by the Hocking Valley Dental Society (HVDS), Fairfield, Perry, Hocking and Athens, or a resident of one of these counties, or an employee of a dentist in the HVDS.

Billy J. Holbrook Memorial – for the non-typical Liberty Union High School graduates.

Home School – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for college students in the manner described: 1. Applicant must be a home schooled student 2. Applicant must be applying to attend a two- or four-year college.

Joseph and P.J. Hoover Family Trust – this fund is for the purpose of providing an educational scholarship for graduates of Fairfield Union High School for the study of art education or early childhood education.

Jenkins Family – recipient must be a resident of Fairfield County, must be enrolled in a post-secondary program and must be studying in the field of education or health care.

Johns Family – for graduates of Amanda-Clearcreek High School.

Trevor and Violet Jones Memorial – for graduates of Millersport High School.

Corey Kissling Memorial – for graduating seniors, in college preparation program of Logan High School who will attend a two-year or four-year college/ university program.

Robert Knisley Fire Service – for graduates of a Fairfield County high school who want to pursue a career in the fire service and are attending a college pursuing a fire science degree or a vocational school pursuing a state of Ohio certification in a fire or EMS field. Children of present/former Lancaster Fire Department members will be given preference and can be graduates of any high school.

Keith A. Kumler Vocational – for Fairfield County students to attend an accredited vocational or technical school for study in the automotive field.

Lancaster Camp Ground Quality of Life – to provide financial support for the purpose of improving the quality of life for residents living on the Lancaster Camp Ground. The fund will offer assistance and help to defray costs in the following areas: Youth camps such as, but not limited to, church, 4-H, Boy and Girl Scouts; spiritual retreats, mission work and family camps; life enrichment experiences for seniors 55 and older.

Lancaster-Fairfield Chamber of Commerce – for students graduating from a Fairfield County high school.

Lancaster High School Band Boosters – music scholarship for students graduating from Lancaster High School and who have been members of the Lancaster High School Instrumental Music Program.

Lancaster High School Class of 1957 Memorial – to provide educational scholarships for Lancaster High School graduates. Recipient must be currently enrolled in or have been accepted into a program leading to a bachelor or associate degree, demonstrate potential for high school or post-high academic achievement, and show financial need.

Lancaster High School Class of 1959 – this scholarship is for a senior graduate of Lancaster High School 1. Recipient must not be a recipient of any other scholarship. FCF will confirm with LHS Guidance Department before actual selection of recipient. 2. Recipient must be attending any post-secondary education program and/or a traditional four-year college. This could include: community college, liberal arts college, universities, vocational schools, trade schools, institutes of technology or professional schools. 3. Recipient must be a student who, in the committee’s opinion, deserves assistance, even though they have not qualified for other scholarships. 4. Recipient should be involved in school and community activities.

Lancaster High School Class of 1964 – to provide educational scholarships for a senior graduate of Lancaster High School. Recipient must not be a recipient of any other scholarship at the time of application. Recipient must be attending any post-secondary education program and/or a traditional four-year college. This could include: community college, liberal arts college, universities, vocational schools, trade schools, institutes of technology or professional schools. Recipient must be a student who, in the committee’s opinion, deserves assistance, even though they haven’t qualified for other scholarships. Recipient should be involved in school and community activities.

Lancaster Junior Women’s Club – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships to support high school females in Lancaster entering their freshman year in an undergraduate college or university program who volunteer in their community in the following manner: Female living and attending high school in the city of Lancaster who are already accepted into an undergraduate degree program for the academic year immediately following completing their high school diploma. This would include home-schooled or any traditional high school program. Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Volunteers for a certified 501(c)3 organization for a minimum 20 hours in the prior 12 months from submitting the application.

Lancaster Kiwanis Club – for students graduating from a high school located in Fairfield County, Ohio, or to graduates of a high school located in Fairfield County, Ohio.

Erik J. Landis Memorial – to provide scholarships for graduating seniors from Fairfield Union High School.

Jamey Landis Memorial – to provide scholarships to Fairfield County high school seniors who are participating in track, cross country or FFA.

Malinda Lifer – for recent graduates of Bloom-Carroll High School or Lancaster High School who plan to major in elementary education at Ohio University Lancaster.

Officer Brett Markwood – to provide scholarships for Fairfield County students to attend a police academy, technical school for law enforcement training, or four-year college in a law enforcement-related field.

Clark M. McGhee and Carol T. McGhee – for students possessing the following qualifications: the student is a child of a current employee of Westerman, Inc., provided such employee has been employed by Westerman, Inc., for at least 12 months prior to the date the scholarship application is received, or the student has been a resident of Rushcreek Township for at least 12 months immediately preceding the date his or her scholarship application is received, or the student is a graduate of Fairfield Union High School, or the student has been a resident of Fairfield County for at least 12 months immediately preceding the date his or her scholarship application is received.

Randy E. Miller – to provide financial assistance to Pickaway/Fairfield County students pursuing EMT/Firefighters degree/training or for a degree in music education.



Ruth E. Miller – for the purposes of providing an opportunity for a college and university education for persons from Lancaster and Fairfield County whose financial condition is such that they would not otherwise be able to procure a college or university education without the scholarship. Where possible, preference should be given to those applicants who have demonstrated the qualities of hard work, scholastic attainment, Christian moral values, and love of family and country.

John Morrow Music Booster (Pickerington Music Boosters) – for Pickerington High School graduates who are members of the music program.

Mt. Pleasant Kiwanis – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for graduates of Fairfield County high schools or residents of Fairfield County who graduate from high schools outside the county in the manner described: 1. The high school and the school the student plans to attend must be accredited by the North Central Association, Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement 2. The student must be a graduating senior from a Fairfield County high school starting their freshman year of college and entering a school qualified under the criteria above. Current students or students formerly enrolled in a school of higher education are not eligible.

Elizabeth “Libby” Murry – scholarship recipient shall be a graduating senior or graduate of Jonathan Alder High School, Plain City, Ohio. The recipient shall pursue a degree in the study of education and/or excel in the field of science. Awards may be made for any four-year or two-year accredited college.

Roger Pedigo Memorial – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for selected high school seniors from Athens, Hocking, Vinton, Fairfield and Franklin counties who are furthering their education by attending Ohio University in the following manner: Applicants must have maintained a high school GPA of 3.0 or above. Applicants must possess leadership

skills and have participated in community service work. Special favor will be given to applicants whose families will exhibit financial hardship through the funding of their child’s furthering education.

William D. Queen – to benefit students from Fairfield Union. Special consideration is given to candidates majoring in math or computer sciences.

LaVerne Raab – for graduates of Fairfield County high schools for undergraduate tuition and expenses.

Stori Huston Raver – to provide scholarships for a graduating special education senior from Fairfield Union High School. The scholarship may be used for a two-year or four-year college, vocational school, technical school, apprenticeship or for support upon entering the work force.

Gladys M. Reber – provide scholarships for students at the Maple Street United Methodist Church.

Kathleen K. Ridenour Memorial – for the purpose of providing scholarships to 9th grade students at the Sheridan Middle School with career interests in becoming a teacher, to be used once they graduate high school and are enrolled in college.

The Rushcreek Grange – provide scholarships for graduates of Fairfield County high schools who are residents of Rushcreek Township for at least 12 months prior to application. The recipient must be alcohol, tobacco and drug free. May be awarded for any four-year, two-year or technical college.

Mollee J. Seifert – for graduating seniors from Fisher Catholic and Lancaster high schools seeking advanced education at an accredited institution.

Richard F. Shannon – scholarships to Ohio University Athens and Ohio University Lancaster for graduates of Lancaster High School. Priorities given to students whose parents are deceased, single-parent families and low-income families.

Jack and Elsie Smith – for Fairfield Union graduates with special consideration given to residents of the former Pleasantville School District.

Russell N. & Clarice H. Stemen – provide scholarships for post-high school students who are members of the Calvary United Methodist Church or the Bremen Bethel Presbyterian Church of Bremen, Ohio, for at least three years preceding their senior year in high school. Selection shall be based on financial need. May be awarded for a four-year, two-year vocational or technical college education.

Dr. Thomas E. Stenger – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for college students in the manner described: 1. Applicant must be a graduate of William V. Fisher High School. 2. Preference given to a degree in the health care field. 3. Preference given to a student of good academic standing.

Kelley and Don Thomas Memorial – for the purpose of providing an annual scholarship to a senior soccer athlete at Pickerington High School North and Pickerington High School Central.

Hannah E. Thrash – to provide scholarships to enhance excellence in music with an emphasis on voice. Eligible applicants must be a resident of Fairfield County and should have exhibited a preference for and an interest in vocal music by the applicant’s high school activities.

Kenneth D. & Zita M. Trimmer – 25 percent of this scholarship will help nursing students from Fisher Catholic High School pursue a course of curriculum for a Bachelor’s or Associates degree in nursing in an approved nursing program. The remaining 75 percent will be used for graduates of Fisher Catholic High School or Lancaster High School to pursue a Bachelor’s degree, from any approved college or university, in business administration or a Master’s program in business administration from Harvard University.

Dr. Martha Gesling Weber – for Fairfield County high school graduates. Preference given to students enrolling at Bowling Green State University majoring in education with emphasis on course work leading to certification as a reading specialist.

Weis Family – for Fairfield County students who are attending Ohio University Lancaster for their first two years of college.

Chad Welch – for Liberty Union students who have excelled in athletics and academics.

Bill and Dorothy Wharton – scholarships for students graduating from Fairfield Union High School.

Chris White Memorial – to benefit graduates of Millersport High School.

Charles T. Wilkins – scholarships for residents of city of Lancaster or Fairfield County.

Colonel Robert G. Wilkins Memorial – to provide a scholarship fund that will promote and encourage young adults to pursue a career in the field of aviation.

Emery & Evelyn Williams Education (FMC) – to provide funds to be used for education for employees of Fairfield Medical Center to further their careers in the medical field.

Edgar Work – to benefit students of Fairfield County who will be attending the School of Engineering at Purdue University.

Fannie M. Howe Nursing – for Fairfield County graduates going into the field of nursing.

Lancaster Rotary Club – for students graduating from a Fairfield County high school.

Organizational Endowment Funds

Family Y Endowment – to be used exclusively for the Family Y at the direction of the Y Executive Committee.

Friends of the Lancaster Parks and Recreation Endowment – the benefit and support of the charitable or educational purposes of Lancaster Parks and Recreation and its affiliated agencies.

Habitat For Humanity of Fairfield County Endowment – endowment fund to receive donations from the general public.

Hospice & Health Services Endowment – endowment fund focusing on end-of-life care.

David L. Johns Lancaster Festival Capital Improvement – established in 2010 for the purpose of providing support for capital expenditures of the Lancaster Festival.

Kiwanis Club of Lancaster Endowment – to benefit charitable organizations as directed by the Kiwanis Fund of Lancaster, Ohio, Board of Directors.

Lancaster Arts and Civic Club Endowment – for the support of the Lancaster Arts and Civic Club and its affiliated agencies.

Lancaster Camp Meeting and Church Assembly, Inc. – to provide financial aid and stability for the Lancaster Camp Ground's present and future purposes, objectives, programs and expansion. The goals of the fund are to provide funds to solve special problems or carry out special projects which strengthen, extend and develop the Lancaster Camp Ground's mission.

Lancaster-Fairfield Community Action Agency Endowment – to be used for general support of the Community Action Program Commission of the Lancaster-Fairfield County Area, Inc.

Lancaster Festival – for support of the Lancaster Festival as approved by the Lancaster Festival Board.

Live United Program – support for programs of the United Way of Fairfield County.

New Horizons Youth and Family Center Endowment – for the unrestricted support of the charitable or educational purposes of New Horizons Youth and Family Center and its affiliated agencies.

Pickerington-Violet Township Historical Society Endowment – to provide for the transfer, management and distribution of funds as may be recommended by the Pickerington-Violet Township Historical Society for the purpose of supporting the operations of the Pickerington-Violet Township Historical Society and Museum.

CREATING A VIBRANT GATHERING SPACE

The Salvation Army's Samaritan Center provides an affordable alternative to nursing home or assisted living placement for those adults who require assistance and supervision with daily activities. The mission of the Samaritan Center is to provide a safe and protective environment for adults and elderly of Fairfield and surrounding counties who need socialization, supervision and assistance during the day.

A \$15,000 grant from the Foundation's Alma Busby and Wendel Family funds has afforded the Samaritan Center the opportunity to provide some much-needed improvements to their facilities.

As a result of the grant, the center was able to repaint and install new flooring throughout the entire 2,800 square foot facility, as well as purchase some new furniture. After removing a wallpaper border, the walls were painted a soothing cream color, with an accent wall in a burgundy tone. The commercial grade carpet in the center's main living area and bathrooms was replaced with vinyl plank flooring that resembles wood and the conference room and director's office received new carpet. The original carpet was gathering, creating a tripping hazard, and also required costly and labor intensive monthly cleaning. The new floors are safer, more hygienic and provide for a much more inviting

environment. Services were provided by local companies Enoch Painting and Totten's Flooring.

"Many people come through our facilities on any given day, from clients and staff members to volunteers and performers," said Michele McTeague, Resource Development Manager for the Salvation Army in Fairfield County. "We are just thrilled to have a fresh, updated space for our clients and all of the wonderful people who help us fulfill our mission."

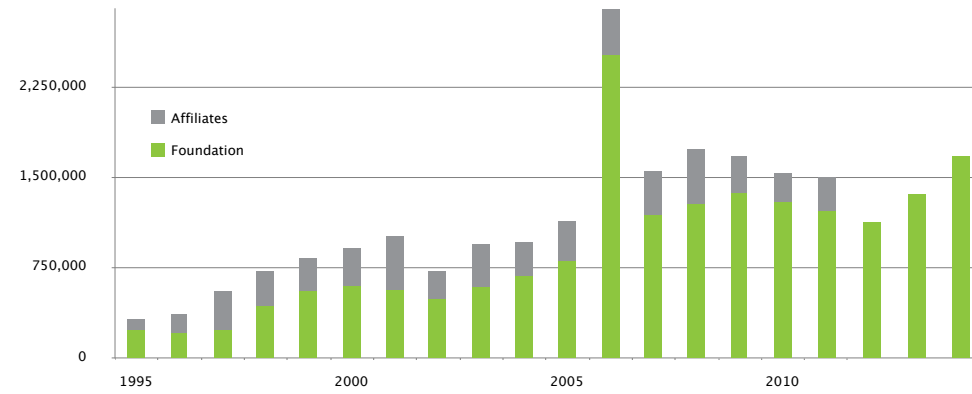

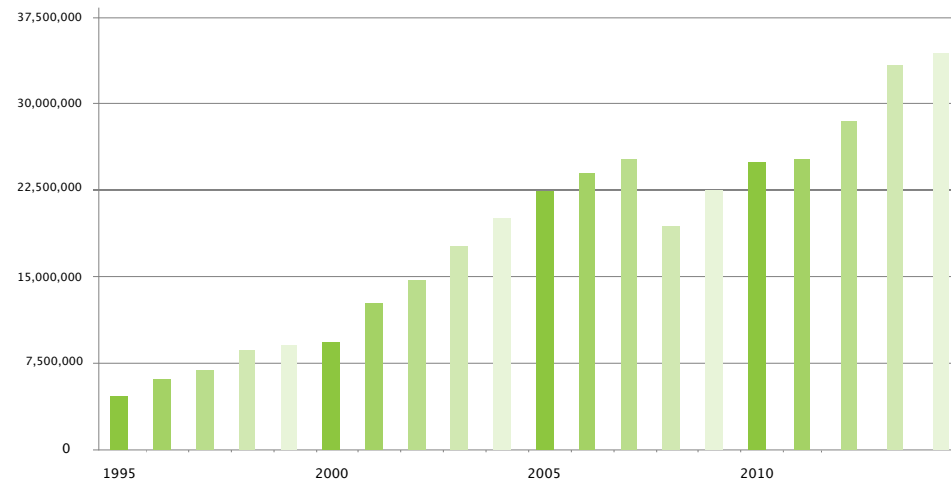

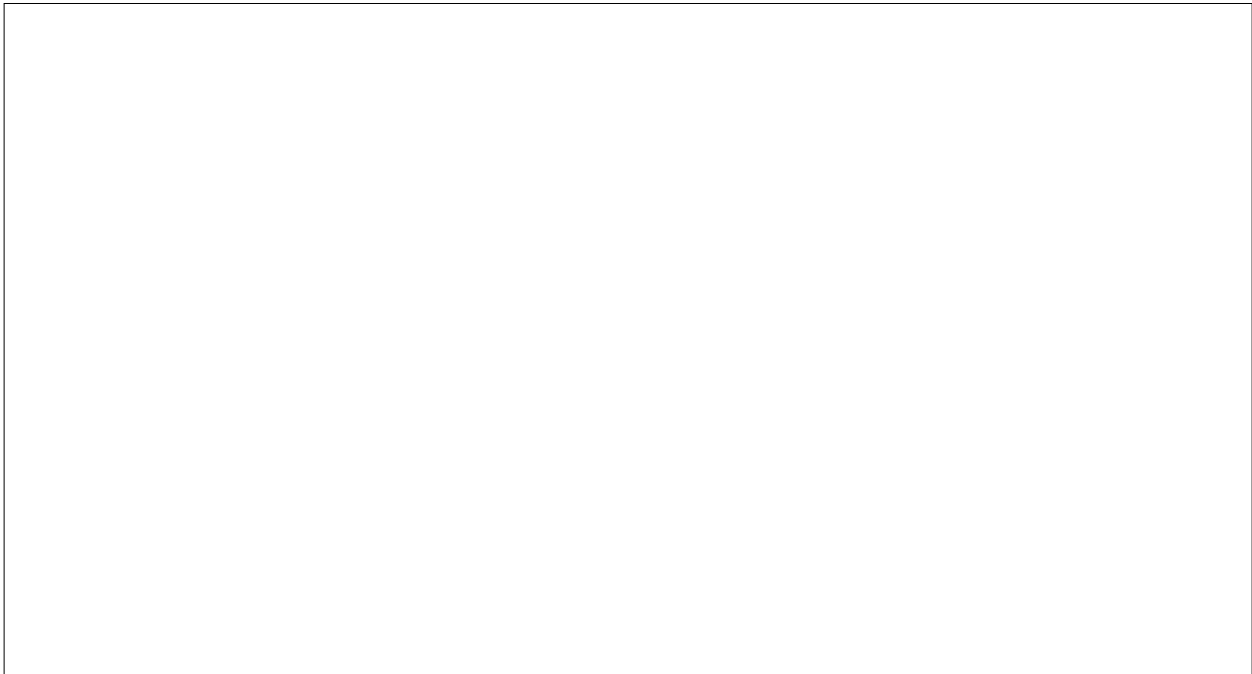
