

"The 25-Hour Give was the perfect way for us to celebrate 25 years of building a legacy, by giving back to those organizations that support our community," said executive director of the Fairfield County Foundation, Amy Eyman. "We're thrilled with the generous amount of donations we were able to match through this event."

30 non profit organizations received part of the \$25,000 match. The Foundation had \$48,536.47 donated, and is matching \$25,140.50 for a total of \$73,676.97 going out to our community in grants.

The 25-Hour Give began at 9 a.m. on May 1, 2014 and donations were accepted until 5 p.m. The Give continued from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. on May 2, 2014.
