FAIRFIELD COUNTY FOUNDATION PROVIDES LOCAL STUDENTS WITH 'OUT OF THIS WORLD' OPPORTUNITY



In October 2018, history was made at Tallmadge Elementary School when students made contact with Astronaut Serena Aunon-Chancellor on the International Space Station (ISS) via Amateur Radio. Students had the opportunity to ask the astronaut questions and find out more about her adventures in space. The activity was part of the Amateur Radio on the International Space Station (ARISS) Program, which promotes learning opportunities as part of the STEM (Science, Technology, Education and Math) initiative. The impact this event had on the community came in many different forms; several media and news outlets attended, along with Ohio State Representative Tim Schaffer and high profile community members.

Before the students could be part of this unique educational experience, the Afterschool Programs of Lancaster and the Lancaster Fairfield County Amateur Radio Club needed the funds to make this happen. In addition to the 21st Century Grant that the Afterschool Programs received to purchase the STEM curriculum to prepare for this event, an additional \$400 grant was awarded by the Fairfield County Foundation to purchase the Space Station Hands-on Learning Equipment.

"We absolutely could not have made this program a reality without the financial assistance of the Fairfield County Foundation. Their generosity provided the students of Tallmadge Elementary a once-in-a-lifetime experience," said Michele Ritchlin, Executive Director of the Afterschool Programs of Lancaster.

The Lancaster Fairfield County Amateur Radio Club received a \$4,200 grant from the McGee Grimm Community Fund that enabled the group to purchase NASA approved radio equipment and antennas to communicate with the ISS.

"Students were amazed by the educational experience and exposure to actually speaking with an astronaut in real time," said John Hilliard, Chief Engineer and Club Trustee of the Lancaster Fairfield County Amateur Radio Club. "If it weren't for the funds we received from the Fairfield County Foundation, this experience might never have happened. It was an event that everyone in attendance will remember for the rest of their lives."

GIFTS



Setting up a Fund with the Foundation

Your Foundation is here to help you build your legacy. We can help you determine your charitable goals, such as deciding if you want family members involved, both now and/or in the future; consider how much involvement you want in selecting the charitable organizations that will receive grants from your fund; and think about how much you want to give in charitable contributions each year and how you want to give it.

We make giving easy and effective, accepting a wide variety of gifts and providing donors with a number of charitable options. Our professional staff has in-depth understanding of the issues, opportunities and resources that shape our community. The Foundation has several options for setting up a fund that best meet your giving goals, including the following:

- **Donor-Advised Funds:** This type of fund enables donors or their designees to recommend grants based on their personal charitable interests.
- **Unrestricted Funds:** Unrestricted Funds are gifts to the Foundation's unrestricted general fund. The principal and income is distributed at the Foundation's discretion in the form of grants to 501(c) (3) organizations. A minimum gift of \$5,000 is required to establish a named fund. Gifts of any amount are accepted into the general fund.
- **Scholarship Funds:** Individuals, families, companies or organizations can establish Scholarship Funds. Once in place, a Scholarship Fund continues to grow with additional contributions from the original donors, from other contributions and through market growth. The donor of a Scholarship Fund has the ability to define the scholarship's advisory committee and the guidelines for candidate selection, requirements and award use.
- **Agency Funds or Endowments:** Agency Funds or Endowments can be created to perpetually support your community service agency. Agency funds hold assets for a charitable organization and distribute the principal or earned income in accordance with the agency's specific instructions.
- **Designated Funds:** Designated Funds are established to ensure that support will be provided to specific eligible non-profit organizations, often organizations that donors have been involved with during their lifetimes. This is an opportunity to leave a lasting legacy in the donor's name.

Making a Gift to the Foundation

A variety of assets can be used to make charitable gifts and there are many ways that you can give immediately or in the future.

- **Cash:** Cash gifts are an easy way to make an impact in your community and allow you to give at any time.
- **Securities:** Securities, both publicly traded and closely held, can be used to set up a fund.
- **Real and Personal Property:** Gifting real and personal property often allows an individual to contribute more than they may have thought possible.
- **IRA/Retirement/Pension Fund Assets:** Retirement assets are most often used as testamentary gifts, creating charitable funds as part of an overall estate plan.
- **Life Insurance:** Life insurance makes it possible to make meaningful gifts to the community.
- **Unique Assets:** Examples might include stamp, coin or art collections; copyrights and patents; royalties; or other unique assets of value.
- **Wills and Bequeaths:** Bequests offer varied ways of giving to the Foundation. Cash securities or other property may be bequeathed in one's will.
- **Charitable Remainder Trusts:** A Charitable Remainder Trust provides life-long income for one or several income beneficiaries, such as the donor and the donor's spouse, and leaves the remainder interest to the Foundation or designated beneficiary.
- **Charitable Lead Trusts:** The income generated from assets placed in a Charitable Lead Trust is paid to the Foundation for a period of years, after which the trust is terminated and the assets are returned to the donor.
- **Charitable Gift Annuities:** The Charitable Gift Annuity can make it possible for donors to assist the community in the future while providing lifetime income for themselves. Upon the death of the donor, the remaining principal is retained by the Foundation to carry out the donor's charitable intentions.
- **Transfer of a Private Foundation:** This type of gift affords many advantages, including lower overhead, staff to assist with charitable goals, and a higher tax deduction for any future gifts, to name a few.

FUNDS



DONOR ADVISED FUNDS

This type of fund is one of our most appealing charitable vehicles. Donor Advised Funds make possible several options, such as: making a charitable gift now; the ability to make suggestions regarding which charities you would like to support; setting up a fund through your will/estate; and naming certain people as advisors to your fund. Donors receive both tax and philanthropic benefits in a simple format with a high degree of flexibility.

John and Marcia Baughman Family – this fund shall be used for the purpose of benefiting the residents and organizations of Fairfield County.

Blue Label/One Write – this fund shall be used for the purpose of benefiting the residents and organizations of Fairfield County.

Christian Stewardship – to provide financial assistance for charitable causes, not exclusively, but with emphasis on supporting Christian-based efforts such as evangelism, missionary support, and providing for the needy both within and outside Fairfield County.

Allison Lynn Conover Memorial – to assist families with ill children from Pickerington and surrounding communities; to make monetary donations to hospitals (Nationwide Children's Hospital and The Ohio State University Pediatric Resident Scholarship Fund) and to give tangible items to the hospital to benefit patients and families that are currently residing there; and to match a dance scholarship for a student at the Judy Dollenmayer Studio of Dance.

Donley Family – distributions shall be made primarily to charitable organizations which provide services primarily in the area of Pickerington or Violet Township, Ohio.

Charles and Diana Eversole Family – to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County, Ohio, for public, charitable and educational purposes, with special consideration given to the Fairfield Heritage Association and matching funds to the Fairfield Medical Center Foundation.

Hubie and Jenny Eyman Memorial – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the residents of Fairfield County.

Lorelei and David Gibbs Family – to support charitable organizations.

Great Commission – to support charitable organizations and to further the teachings of Jesus Christ, whether local, national, or worldwide.

The Rotary Club of Lancaster-Sherman Fred & Margie Hatcher Endowment – to support the needs of the Lancaster and Fairfield County community.

Harcum Family – to provide financial assistance for charitable organizations.

Heiber Family – to be used for public, charitable and education purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the residents of Fairfield County.

Lloyd F. and Diann L. Helber – to support charitable organizations.

Tina Rose B. Herrmann and Kody Alexander Maynard Healing Hearts Memorial – to provide grants and assistance to help victims of violent crimes.

Jackson Family – to provide charitable programs which will aid the children and aged of Fairfield County and Bloom Township.

David L. Johns – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes for Fairfield County.

Jennie L. Johns – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide ultimate benefit for the people of Amanda, Ohio.

Robert C. Kalish Memorial Youth Park Program – to provide funds for a summer youth camp program for fourth and fifth graders attending Liberty Union-Thurston School District or who reside in the school district, at no charge to the child.

The Maggie Fund - Maggie Grace Lyons Memorial – to provide scholarships to Fairfield County students (up to age 21) whose siblings have special needs and/or have severe medical issues. Scholarships can pay for college, camps, classes (i.e. art, music, etc.).

Jayne and Jim McGill Family – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the children in Fairfield County, Ohio.

Terry A. McGhee/Sally J. Grimm Community – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes.

Mowry Family – for public, charitable, and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County.

Ninety One: One Foundation – for the purpose of benefiting the residents and organizations of Fairfield County.

Norman Family – for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County.

Joe Ogilvie – to benefit Duke University, The Inner City Educational Foundation, and grants for educational endeavors in Fairfield County and elsewhere.

Lauryn “Lu” Oliphant Memorial – to provide grants to benefit the residents of Fairfield County or those organizations supported by the Donors and/or to award scholarships to students graduating from Pickerington High School, Pickerington, Ohio.

Pickering Family – to provide funds for charitable purposes in Fairfield County.

Rodenbaugh Family – to provide funds for charitable and educational purposes.

Wayne Roller Memorial – to provide support for grants and scholarships for students, athletes, coaches, teams and officials.

Michael D. Sewell Memorial – for support of the Pickerington Fine Arts programs and local arts groups, limiting help to the state of Ohio, unless a special need is discussed and voted on by the Board of Directors of the Michael D. Sewell Memorial Fund.

Wanda Shaner Memorial – to provide grants and/or scholarships to benefit the residents in Fairfield County.

William J. and Sarah E. Sitterley – for public, charitable, and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County, Ohio.

Brian Stoner Memorial – to provide funds to charitable organizations that are eligible to receive distributions. Preference for grants goes to organizations dealing with individuals with special needs. Preference for scholarships goes to individuals with autism, individuals with other special needs, individuals intending to major in special education, and individuals attending culinary school.

Rich & Delores Troup Family – to provide funds for charitable purposes in Fairfield County.

Vonnie Cares Community Impact – to provide grants to Fairfield County High School students who have a GPA of 3.0 or higher for the purpose of funding a community project to strengthen community relations, to encourage giving and recognize the kindness of others.

John and Jamie Weaver – to make grants to charitable organizations for the purpose of benefiting the residents of Fairfield County and other charitable causes.

Williamson Family – to provide funds for charitable purposes.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Scholarship funds help students pursue their academic goals. The donor may define the guidelines for the recipient, the advisory committee, the school and the award itself.

Matthew Acton – to provide scholarships for senior golf athletes of any Fairfield County High School, Canal Winchester High School, Circleville High School, Logan Elm High School or Teays Valley High School. This scholarship is for any accredited college or vocational school.

The Anderson/Black/Community (ABC) Mini-Scholarship – to provide scholarships to two Bloom Carroll High School students, staff members, administrators, or retired staff members who had five years of service to the Bloom-Carroll Local School District to fund a Christian Mission Trip (CMT) or a Christian Mission Project (CMP).

Roger Anderson – for students residing in Jackson Township of Perry County and majoring in education or business.

The Aranda Notre Dame Law School – to provide scholarships to students who have been accepted to the Notre Dame Law School.

James L. Barrett, M.D. – to provide scholarship assistance to graduates of a Fairfield County High Schools to attend the University of Cincinnati and major in computer science, geology, physics, chemistry, or mathematics.

Paul D. Beck – to provide scholarships for graduates of a Fairfield County, Ohio high school who demonstrate academic ability and maintain a 3.5 GPA in high school and a 3.0 GPA in any undergraduate program.

Bloom-Carroll Alumni Scholar Athlete – for Bloom-Carroll graduates who participate in sports and also demonstrate academic excellence.

William W. Bolsen Memorial – to provide scholarships for graduates of the Ohio State School for the Blind who wish to work toward a degree from a technical, two-year or four-year college.

Marlowe Brainard – to provide a scholarship for students graduating from Millersport High School who desire to continue their education in the field of Arts or Education.

Jean M. Burdette Memorial – for Lancaster High School graduates for study in the field of Special Education.

James Caple – to provide scholarships for post-secondary studies for Fairfield County residents who pursue a course of study in classical vocal or instrumental performance.

Robert E. & Marion A. Carr – for Fairfield County residents who are pursuing a degree in the study of Nursing and/or Teaching/Education.

Molly Ann Clark Memorial – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for students between the ages of 17-21 who are from Fairfield, Perry, Pickaway, Hocking, Licking, Athens or Muskingum county. They must demonstrate an interest in community service and volunteerism; be a past participant (racer) of the Lancaster Soap Box Derby, past Derby queen or have had a family member who either volunteered or served on the board of directors of the Lancaster Soap Box Derby. Applicants meeting the above criteria will be given preference in determining recipients, or a student seeking a degree in substance abuse education may be accepted every even year.

Charles C. & Barbara Claypool – for students seeking educational opportunities in technical fields with a preference toward engineering. Preference given to the children of employees of Claypool Electric Inc. and students planning to attend Ohio Northern University.

Deputy Ethan Collins – to provide scholarships for Fairfield County students to attend an accredited school or academy in preparation for a career in Law Enforcement or continuing education in Law Enforcement.

Coney Memorial – for Fairfield Union High School graduates.

Susie McMackin Crook – will be awarded to a student who has registered and been accepted at Lancaster Montessori School.

D.A.R.E. – scholarship recipient shall be a graduating senior from Lancaster High School, William V. Fisher Catholic High School or Fairfield Christian Academy and a graduate of the D.A.R.E. Program who desires to continue his or her education.

Davidson-J.C. Community Service – to provide scholarships to students of Fairfield County who demonstrate an interest in community service through volunteerism. Jaycees and relatives of current or former Jaycees will be given preference in determining recipients.

Jillian Davidson Memorial – this fund was established by family and friends to honor the memory of Jillian Leigh Davidson who died of a rare blood disease in September 2000. This scholarship is awarded to a female senior basketball or volleyball athlete at Lancaster High School. This award is given to the individual selected by the Davidson Scholarship Committee.

Elsie R. McClelland Davis Memorial – for graduates of Amanda-Clearcreek High School.

Jim DePietro – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for college students in the manner described: 1. Applicant must be a high school senior and a Lancaster Y Swim Team (LYST) swimmer. 2. LYST swimmer must have been a participant of the LYST program for at least two years, prior to application. 3. Seniors wishing to apply will be asked to write an essay, using an essay prompt determined by the (active) LYST Parent Board Committee.

Frank Dillard Memorial/Standing Stone National Bank – for graduates of Fairfield County High Schools. Preference given to biological or legally adopted dependents of Standing Stone National Bank employees. Weighted toward those who plan to major in Business/Finance at Ohio University Lancaster.

Charles E. Dupler – to provide financial assistance to Fairfield Union High School music and F.F.A. students.

Chad Edwards Memorial – to provide scholarships for Fairfield County students to attend an accredited school or academy in preparation for a career in law enforcement or to further their career in law enforcement.

Leroy and Bernice Ellinger Memorial – for any graduate of a Fairfield County high school or any graduate from a high school in Worthington, Ohio. Preference will be given to a graduate of Lancaster High School. Applicant must be a college junior or senior and preference given to an accredited four-year college. Recipient must have at least a 2.75 GPA going into their junior year.

Fairfield County Educational Service Center Superintendent's Scholarship – for students within Fairfield County based on academic and athletic achievement.

Fairfield Federal Ron Keaton – to provide scholarships for Lancaster High School senior varsity girls basketball players.

Amelia Fickel – Glenn Moodie – to provide scholarships for graduates of Perry-Southern Local School District. Special consideration given to graduates who are residents of the former New Straitsville School District. Selection shall be based on financial need. May be awarded for a four-year, two-year vocational or technical college education.

George and Marilyn Finnen Education – to provide scholarships for Lancaster High School graduates majoring in the field of Education. This fund was established by a gift from George Finnen in memory of his wife Marilyn.

Wilfred and Una Fosnaugh – for residents of Fairfield County, Ohio pursuing a bachelor degree in Education at any accredited educational institution and is need based.

Lynn and Lynda Freisner – to award a scholarship annually to any student, Freshman through Graduate level, but only awarded for a single year for each student. Recipient must be a resident of Rushcreek Township or a member of Bremen Bethel Presbyterian Church (BBPC). In addition, recipient must be attending either The Ohio State University or Ohio University.

Lorelei Owen Gibbs – for residents of Fairfield County pursuing a university degree in Elementary education or Nursing.

Patricia Woodyard Gilmore Memorial – to provide educational scholarships for students who have graduated from a high school in Fairfield County and plan to attend a 4-year college or trade school program in Ohio.

The Jack Greathouse Gale Force Basketball – to provide educational scholarships for Lancaster High School seniors who were boy's basketball players.

O.J. Green Memorial – to be used to provide scholarships to the most inspirational senior football player and to one senior Art student at Canal Winchester High School.

Robert V. Grilli Memorial – to provide a scholarship for graduates of Lancaster High School and Fisher Catholic High School who desire to continue their education in a collegiate and/or graduate institution.

Jacob Guisinger Memorial – to provide scholarships for graduates of Berne Union High School. The recipient will be determined on the basis of academic merit, economic need, athletics, and community involvement and must be seeking advanced education at any accredited educational institution.

Nils Gustavson Scholar Athlete – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for a graduating senior of Lancaster High School with good academic standing and qualities of a scholar athlete. Student must attend an Ohio school.

J. Jay Hampson – for students residing in Fairfield County and attending Ohio Northern University.

Doug Henwood Memorial – to provide scholarships to Lancaster High School graduates who participate in Track and Field and may be involved in Track and Field at the collegiate level.

William D. Hilyard Family – to be used to reward the outstanding senior music student of Fairfield Union High School. The award shall be known as the “Robert Trocchia Outstanding Music Student Award” given by the Family of William D. Hilyard.

Hocking Valley Dental Society – to provide scholarships for students in Dental Hygiene or Expanded Function Dental Assisting. Students must be a graduate of a high school within the counties served by the Hocking Valley Dental Society (HVDS), Fairfield, Perry, Hocking and Athens, or a resident of one of these counties, or, an employee of a dentist in the HVDS.

Billy J. Holbrook Memorial – for a graduating senior of Liberty Union High School.

Home School – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for home-schooled students applying to attend a 2 or 4-year college.

Henry and Eleanor Hood – to provide scholarship(s) to Fairfield County residents who are graduates of Lancaster High School, have completed the LHS STEM program, have been admitted to an accredited 4-year college or university with the intent to major in Engineering or Bio Medical Sciences.

Joseph and P.J. Hoover Family Trust – this fund is for the purpose of providing an educational scholarship for graduates of Fairfield Union High School for the study of art education or early childhood education.

Larry L. Hoover Memorial – to provide scholarships to college juniors or seniors majoring in Agriculture or a field related to Agriculture.

Hutton Family – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for the study of Nursing. The recipient shall be entering at least his or her Junior or Senior (year) in college and shall be a resident of Fairfield County.

Johns Family – for graduates of Amanda-Clearcreek High School.

Trevor and Violet Jones Memorial – for graduates of Millersport High School.

The Carolyn L. Joos Memorial – for an academic scholarship for Fisher Catholic High School students.

Corey Kissling Memorial – for graduating seniors of Logan High School who are in a college preparation program and will attend a two-year or four-year college/university program.

Robert Knisley Fire Service – for graduates of a Fairfield County high school who want to pursue a career in the fire service and are attending a college pursuing a fire science degree or a vocational school pursuing a state of Ohio certification in a fire or EMS field. Children of present/former Lancaster Fire Department members will be given preference and can be graduates of any high school.

Keith A. Kumler Vocational – for Fairfield County students to attend an accredited vocational or technical school for study in the automotive field.

Lancaster Boys Soccer Booster Club – for providing scholarships to deserving Lancaster High School boys soccer seniors.

Lancaster Camp Ground Quality of Life – for the purpose of improving the quality of life for residents living on the Lancaster Camp Ground. The fund will offer assistance and help to defray costs in the following areas: Youth camps such as, but not limited to, church, 4-H, Boy and Girl Scouts, spiritual retreats, mission work, family camps, and life enrichment experiences for seniors 55 and older.

Lancaster Community Chorus – to provide scholarships for students majoring in Music Education, Music Therapy, or Music Performance. Students must be graduates of schools in Fairfield County or counties contiguous to Fairfield County and must have achieved at least sophomore status at their universities and maintained a 2.5 GPA.

Lancaster-Fairfield Chamber of Commerce – for students graduating from a Fairfield County high school intending a career in business.

Lancaster High School Band Boosters – for students graduating from Lancaster High School who have been members of the Lancaster High School Instrumental Music Program for at least three years.

Lancaster High School Class of 1957 Memorial – to provide educational scholarships for Lancaster High School graduates. Recipient must be currently enrolled in or have been accepted into a program leading to a bachelor or associate degree, demonstrate potential for high school or post high academic achievement and show financial need.

Lancaster High School Class of 1959 – this scholarship is for a senior graduate of Lancaster High School. Recipient must not be a recipient of any other scholarship and must be attending a post-secondary education program and/or a traditional four-year college. This could include: community college, liberal arts college, universities, vocational schools, trade schools, institutes of technology or professional schools. Recipient must be a student who, in the committee's opinion, deserves assistance, even though they have not qualified for other scholarships, and the recipient should be involved in school and community activities.

Lancaster High School Class of 1964 – to provide an educational scholarship for a graduating senior of Lancaster High School. Recipient must not be a recipient of any other scholarship at the time of application. Recipient must be attending any post-secondary education program and/or a traditional four-year college. This could include: community college, liberal arts college, universities, vocational schools, trade schools, institutes of technology or professional schools. Recipient must be a student who, in the committee's opinion, deserves assistance, even though they haven't qualified for other scholarships. Recipient should be involved in school and community activities.

Lancaster Junior Women's Club – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships to support females who attend a high school, or who are home schooled, in Lancaster and are entering their freshman year in an undergraduate college or university program. Recipients must volunteer in their community for a certified 501(c)3 organization for a minimum 20 hours in the prior 12 months from submitting the application and must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

Lancaster Kiwanis Club – for students graduating from a high school located in Fairfield County, Ohio.

Erik J. Landis Memorial – to provide scholarships for graduating seniors from Fairfield Union High School who will be attending an accredited educational institution. Recipients will be chosen based on academic merit, economic need, and community involvement.

Jamey Landis Memorial – to provide scholarships to Fairfield County high school seniors who participated in track, cross country, or FFA.

Malinda Lifer – for recent graduates of Bloom-Carroll High School or Lancaster High School who plan to major in elementary education at Ohio University Lancaster.

Frank P. Maguire – to provide scholarships to students who graduate from a high school in Fairfield County, Ohio whose parent(s) served or are serving in the U.S. military.

Officer Brett Markwood – to provide scholarships for Fairfield County students to attend a police academy, a technical school for law enforcement training, or a four-year college in a law enforcement-related field.

V. Ben Martin – for graduates of a Fairfield County high school who have been accepted to the Fisher College of Business at The Ohio State University.

Clark M. McGhee and Carol T. McGhee – for students who are residents of Rushcreek Township for at least 12 months; or are, or will be, graduates of Fairfield Union High School, or have been residents of Fairfield County for at least 12 months.

Randy E. Miller – to provide financial assistance to Pickaway/Fairfield County students pursuing EMT/Firefighters degree/training or a degree in music education.

Ruth E. Miller – for the purposes of providing an opportunity for a college and university education for persons from Lancaster and Fairfield County whose financial condition is such that they would not otherwise be able to procure a college or university education without the scholarship. Where possible, preference should be given to those applicants who have demonstrated the qualities of hard work, scholastic attainment, Christian moral values, and love of family and country.

John Morrow Music Booster (Pickerington Music Boosters) – for Pickerington High School graduating seniors who were members of the music program.

Mt. Pleasant Kiwanis – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for graduates of Fairfield County high schools or for residents of Fairfield County who graduate from high schools outside the county who plan to attend an institution accredited by the North Central Association or Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement.

Elizabeth “Libby” Murry – scholarship recipient shall be a graduating senior or graduate of Jonathan Alder High School, Plain City, Ohio. The recipient shall pursue a degree in the study of Education and/or excel in the field of science. Awards may be made for any four-year or two-year accredited college.

The Tammy Nusser Foundation – to support those individuals who have cancer, or their children, by awarding educational scholarships to help offset the cost of college expenses.

Roger Pedigo Memorial – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for selected high school graduating seniors attending Ohio University

who have at least a 3.0 GPA, leadership skills, and community service and are from Athens, Hocking, Vinton, Fairfield and Franklin counties. Special favor will be given to applicants whose families will exhibit financial hardship through the funding of their child’s furthering education.

William D. Queen – to benefit students from Fairfield Union. Special consideration is given to candidates majoring in math or computer sciences.

LaVerne Raab – for graduates of Fairfield County high schools for undergraduate tuition.

Stori Huston Raver – to provide a scholarship for a graduating special education senior from Fairfield Union High School. The scholarship may be used for a two-year or four-year college, vocational school, technical school, apprenticeship or for support upon entering the work force.

Gladys M. Reber – to provide educational scholarships for students who have been involved with the Maple Street United Methodist Church.

Kathleen Kaser Ridenour Memorial – to be used for the purpose of providing scholarships to Perry county residents. Applicants must be 9th grade students at the Sheridan Middle School with career interests in becoming a teacher. The scholarship will be awarded once the student graduates from high school and is enrolled in college.

Kathleen K. Ridenour Memorial – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for Sheridan High School seniors with a 2.2 or higher GPA., who have obtained a letter of recommendation from a Sheridan High School teacher, and have completed the application fully.

Robert Rowles Family – to provide educational scholarships for students who are residents of Fairfield County, who are graduates of Fairfield Union High School, are enrolled in a post-secondary program, and have a financial need which might keep them from otherwise attending college.

The Rushcreek Grange – to provide scholarships for graduates of Fairfield County high schools who are residents of Rushcreek Township for at least 12 months prior to application. The recipient must be alcohol, tobacco and drug free. May be awarded for any four-year, two-year or technical college.

Mollee J. Seifert – for graduating seniors from Fisher Catholic and Lancaster High Schools seeking advanced education at an accredited institution.

Shaner-Wohrer Memorial – to provide college scholarships to graduating senior girls’ volleyball students from Lancaster High School, in Fairfield County.

Shannon Family – scholarships to Ohio University Athens and Ohio University Lancaster for graduates of Lancaster High School. Priorities given to students whose parents are deceased, single-parent families and low-income families.

Tyler C. Sharpe Memorial – to provide a scholarship to a graduating senior within the Muskingum Valley League (MVL) residents who will be pursuing a university degree. Recipient must compete on his or her high school Cross Country team and display academic excellence.

Jack and Elsie Smith – for Fairfield Union graduates with special consideration given to residents of the former Pleasantville School District.

Russell N. & Clarice H. Stemen – to provide scholarships for post-high school students who were members of the Calvary United Methodist Church or the Bremen Bethel Presbyterian Church of Bremen, Ohio for at least three years preceding their senior year in high school. Selection shall be based on financial need. May be awarded for a four-year, two-year vocational or technical college education.

Dr. Thomas E. Stenger – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for graduates of William V. Fisher High School. Preference is given to students pursuing a degree in the health care field and to students with good academic standing.

Ryan Stoneburner Memorial – to provide a scholarship(s) to Amanda-Clearcreek graduates pursuing a university degree in Physical Therapy.

Steven E. Svoboda – to provide educational scholarships for students pursuing a degree in the field of technology with special consideration given to students studying Engineering or Auto Mechanics.

Kelley and Don Thomas Memorial – to provide an annual scholarship to a senior soccer athlete at Pickerington High School North and Pickerington High School Central.

Hannah E. Thrash – to provide scholarships to enhance excellence in music with an emphasis on voice. Eligible applicants must be a resident of Fairfield County and should have exhibited a preference for and an interest in vocal music by the applicant’s high school activities.

Andrew “Drew” Townsend-Engle Memorial – to provide scholarships for senior choir students at Lancaster High School who have a passion for singing and performing and intend to major in Music.

Kenneth D. & Zita M. Trimmer – 25 percent of this scholarship will help students from Fisher Catholic High School pursue a Bachelor’s or Associates’ degree in nursing in an approved nursing program. The remaining 75 percent will be used for graduates of Fisher Catholic High School or Lancaster High School to pursue a Bachelor’s degree from any approved college or university in Business Administration or a Master’s program in Business Administration from Harvard University.

Wilbur O. Turner and Anita M. Turner and Mildred L. Hatter and Frank H. Hatter – for scholarships and tuition assistance for graduates of Lancaster High School who attend seminary school or pursue a career in the medical profession.



CHERISHING 35 YEARS OF THE LANCASTER FESTIVAL

Since its inception in 1985, the Lancaster Festival has served as an unprecedented celebration of the arts in Fairfield County and beyond. The Foundation's strategic growth and management of the Lancaster Festival Endowment Fund has flourished into additional funds to reach various goals for the future of the festival:

Unrestricted Festival Fund – Exists to fund programs that will contribute to the achievements of the Lancaster Festival.

Lancaster Festival Endowment Fund – Established to support the Lancaster Festival as approved by the Lancaster Festival Board.

Friends of Michael Davis Memorial – Funding for the purpose of providing annual fellowship positions in the Lancaster Festival Orchestra.

Chad Welch Memorial – for Liberty Union students who have excelled in athletics and academics.

Bill and Dorothy Wharton – scholarships for students graduating from Fairfield Union High School who will be attending a university in Ohio. Recipients will be chosen based on academic merit, character, personality, leadership potential, and financial need.

Chris White Memorial – for scholarships for graduates of Millersport High School.

Charles T. Wilkins – for scholarships for residents of city of Lancaster or Fairfield County.

Colonel Robert G. Wilkins Memorial – to provide a scholarship fund that will promote and encourage young adults to pursue a career in the field of aviation.

Edgar Work – for scholarships for students of Fairfield County. Special consideration will be given to those students who will be attending the School of Engineering at Purdue University.

PROVIDES NOURISHMENT FOR COMMUNITY SENIORS

A booming elder population left Meals on Wheels of Fairfield County, Inc. facing a critical need to expand their facilities to serve vulnerable seniors. When the organization relocated to the retired Cedar Heights school building, renovations were essential to make the space accessible and equipped for community use.

The Fairfield County Foundation awarded Meals on Wheels a \$100,000 grant from The George and Dollie L. Zimpfer Memorial Fund to develop a commercial kitchen and ADA accommodations for seniors to safely and independently enjoy their visits. The expansions allowed the organization to grow from serving 700 seniors annually to more than 2,000 seniors each year.

"When thinking about upgrading to a new facility to accommodate seniors, key drivers in the design were safety, accessibility, security, and workflow. We wanted the new facility to be comfortable and welcoming to the seniors," said Anna Tobin, Executive Director of Meals on Wheels of Fairfield County, Inc. "We're more than just a meal, we're the senior services hub for our county. The Fairfield County Foundation's support allows us to meet the demand for services for one of our community's largest groups."

SCHOLARSHIP HONORS LEGACY OF LOCAL STUDENT

The Tyler C. Sharpe Memorial Fund was established with the Fairfield County Foundation to honor the 4.0 Academic All-Ohio student and cross-country team member from Sheridan High School after he tragically passed away in 2016. In honor of Tyler's legacy of academic excellence, love and laughter, scholarships are awarded to cross-country runners from the Muskingum Valley League who achieve a 3.0 GPA or higher. Most importantly to the Sharpe family, scholarship recipients are students who display values of kindness and giving back to others in reflection of how Tyler lived his life.

"The Foundation has been fabulous to work with. They made it easy for us to do what we wanted," said Lisa Sharpe, Tyler's mother. "They are so nice and helpful if I have a question. It has been extremely easy throughout an otherwise difficult process. It feeds our hearts."

Scholarship fundraising is accomplished through an annual golf outing and a 5K, with both events paying heartwarming tributes to Tyler. Lisa Sharpe says the outing is held on the course where Tyler learned to golf, noting their frequent exchange: "What is today? A good day for golf." The 5K gathers current runners and alumni who share Tyler's love for cross-country, cheering on others and his community.

Scholarship recipient families are thankful for the Sharpe family's generous actions to remember Tyler by helping others. Carol Brown, mother of scholarship recipient Luke Brown, says the scholarship has eased her family's concerns about college.

"It is so amazing how this family has chosen to carry out Tyler's legacy. His family has taken on the role of 'what would Tyler want me to do?'" says Carol Brown. "To award this money to kids that have a similar personality and reflect his goals shows how much thought they put into this effort."

The Sharpe family is eager to see the scholarship carry on Tyler's legacy to help students who mirror his values and carry on his impact.

GRANT SUPPORTS EXPANSION OF HUMANE SOCIETY

The Fairfield Area Humane Society received \$45,000 from the George and Dollie L. Zimpfer Memorial Fund for a 1,300 square foot expansion to meet a growing community need for a low-cost clinic, grooming and boarding services. “Any of the services we’ve added are based on what the community and our animals need the most,” said Corey Schoonover, Executive Director of the Fairfield Area Humane Society.

Schoonover explained that Fairfield County often sees cases of neglect stemming from a lack of affordable vet care. Foundation funding made it possible to offer a clinic with quick-to-obtain, low-cost basic care and exams one day per week. The clinic has recently expanded to include blood work and has plans for new ways to provide affordable resources to keep pets happy and healthy.

“The Foundation is incredibly easy to work with. If you have a concise plan and you have a need and can show it, they are more than willing to help you meet that need,” said Schoonover.

With adoptions more than tripling in recent years, the Humane Society is dedicated to turning financial support immediately into more services for the local community.
