The deadline for the 2022-2023 scholarship application is quickly approaching. The application will close at **11:59 p.m. on Friday, March 11, 2022**. Shortly after,

Students who receive a scholarship offer from an online scholarship will be notified via the email address used to log on to their account. Not all scholarships are awarded at the same time. Students will need to complete follow-up information in the online portal, if awarded.
