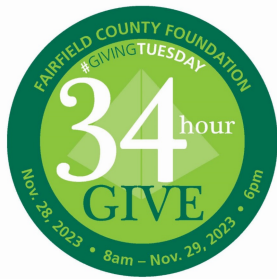

Youth Advisory Committee

On October 17th, we kicked off the 6th year of our Youth Advisory Committee at the Ohio Glass Museum. We invited 11th and 12th grade representatives from all 11 high schools in the county and had 14 students in attendance.

During the meeting, the Ohio Glass Museum shared about their mission and activities at the museum and welcomed the students to come back to visit and volunteer.



Since its inception, the Youth Advisory Committee has had over 70 students participate. These students have awarded over \$63,000 to 50 unique programs led by nonprofits in Fairfield County. We are excited about our newest group of students and can't wait to see what other programs and nonprofits they impact through this grant process.

Scholarship Application Opens December 1

The scholarship application for the 2024-2025 school year will open on December 1, 2023 to anyone seeking financial support to further their education. Opportunities are available for everyone from graduating high school seniors to graduate students, as well as those attending a vocational or technical school! First-time applicants are welcomed at ANY point in their post-secondary journey and all applicants must apply EACH year.

This year there is an updated FAFSA, which will be coming out sometime in December. Make sure you check with your high school to find out when they have a scholarship and FAFSA night scheduled with the Fairfield County Foundation.

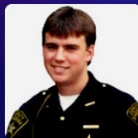


Thinking about law enforcement or know someone who is? Check out these scholarship opportunities!

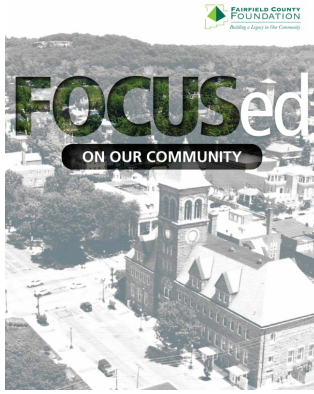
