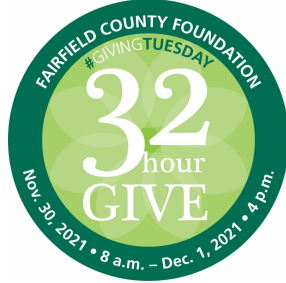


32-HOUR GIVE

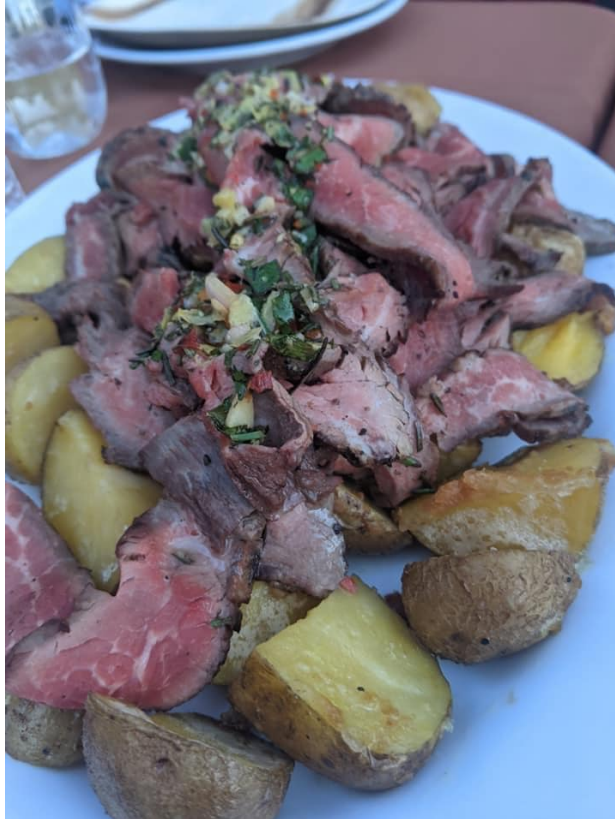
250 PLATES COMMUNITY MEAL

More than 30 women attended, including five new members, to connect and hear presentations from Andrea Spires of United Way of Fairfield County and Stephanie Taylor of Habitat for Humanity of Southeast Ohio. Members voted to provide \$6,075 in funding for Habitat for Humanity to support their first build in Fairfield County in several years, which will be in Pleasantville.

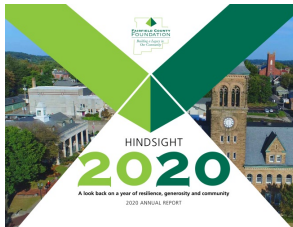

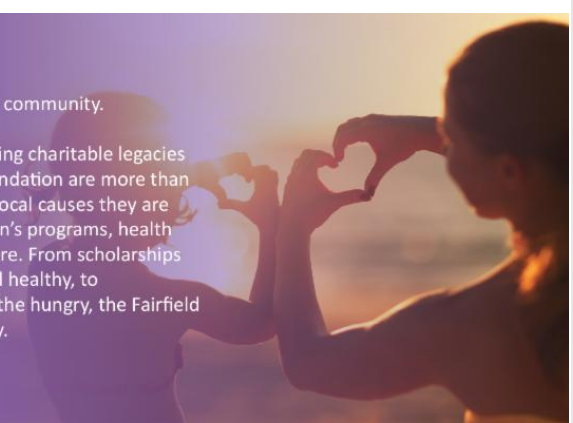
