CYCLE 2:

- Preliminary Grants: Due second Monday in May – May 9, 2022
- Invitations to submit full grant sent second week of May
- Grant Application: Due second Monday of June – June 13, 2022
- Grant Committee recommendations to Board of Trustees for approval – July 21, 2022

CYCLE 3:

- Preliminary Grants: Due second Monday in September – September 12, 2022
- Invitations to submit full grant sent second week of September
- Grant Application: Due second Monday of October – October 10, 2022
- Grant Committee recommendations to Board of Trustees for approval – November 17, 2022
