- Invitations to submit full grant sent second week of May
- Grant Application: Due second Monday of June – June 10, 2019
- Grant Committee recommendations to Board of Trustees for approval – July 18, 2019

CYCLE 3:

- Preliminary Grants: Due second Monday in September – September 9, 2019
- Invitations to submit full grant sent second week of September
- Grant Application: Due second Monday of October – October 14, 2019
- Grant Committee recommendations to Board of Trustees for approval – November 21, 2019
